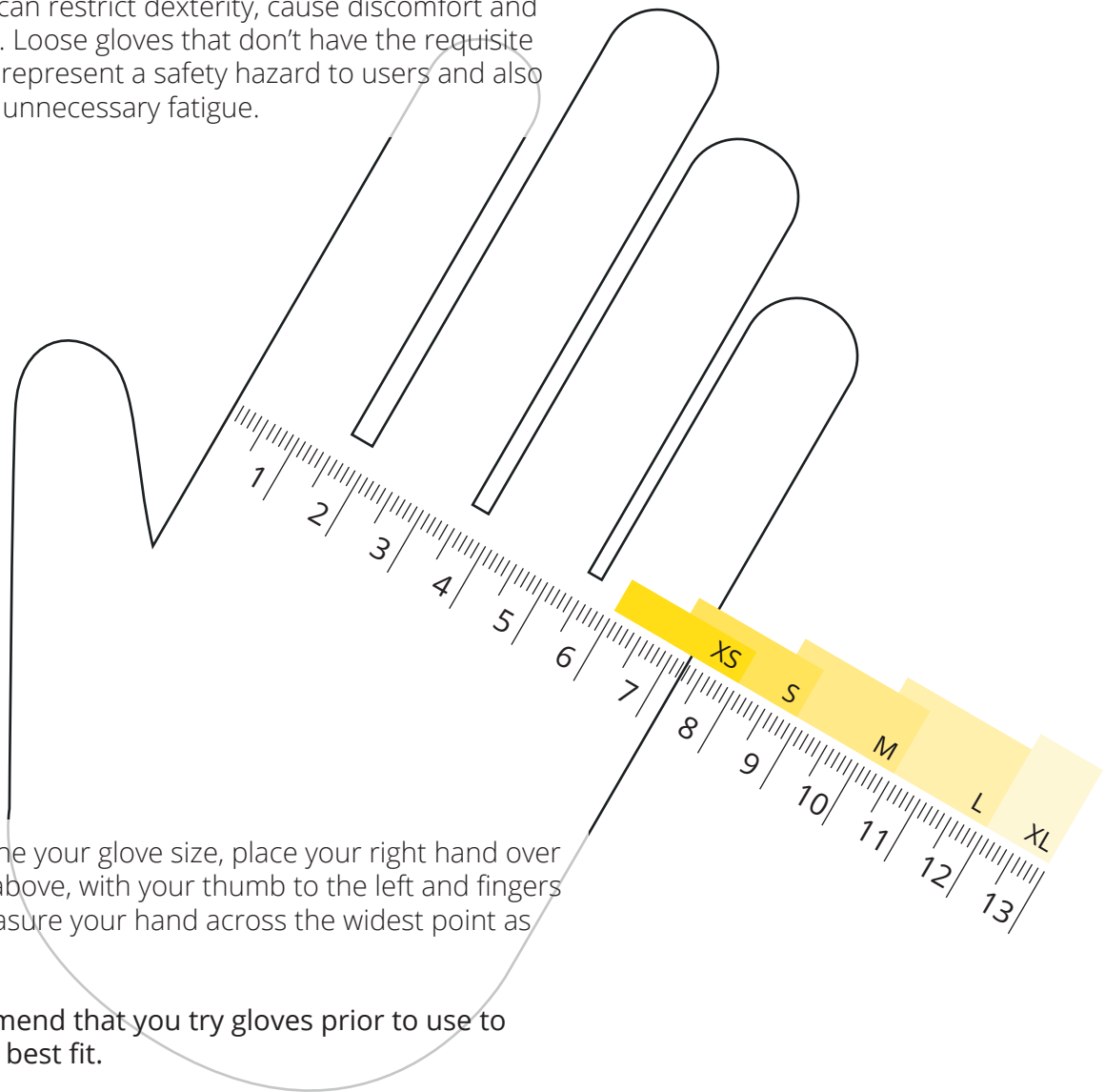


Unigloves

Glove Sizing Guide

Wearing the right size glove is important.

Tight gloves can restrict dexterity, cause discomfort and hand fatigue. Loose gloves that don't have the requisite stretchiness represent a safety hazard to users and also can result in unnecessary fatigue.



To determine your glove size, place your right hand over the image above, with your thumb to the left and fingers closed. Measure your hand across the widest point as depicted.

We recommend that you try gloves prior to use to ensure the best fit.

Examination Glove Size	Palm Width
Extra Small (XS)	up to 80 m.m.
Small (S)	70 to 90 m.m.
Medim (M)	85 to 105 m.m.
Large (L)	100 to 120 m.m.
Extra large (XL)	≥ 120 m.m.
